

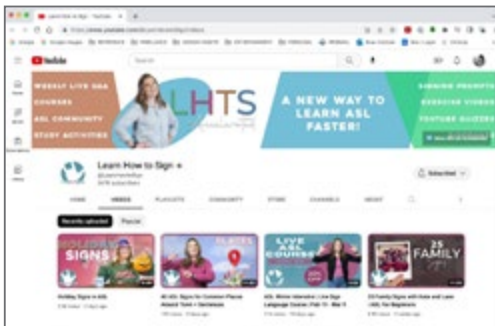

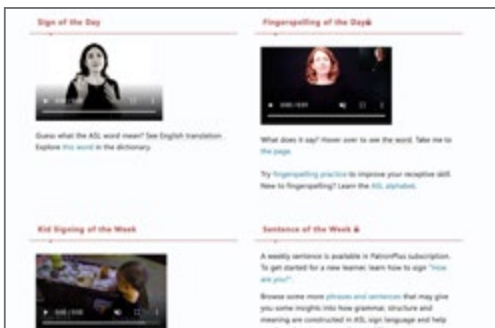
SMALL GROUP WEB PAGE - <http://triliumdesign.com/sign>

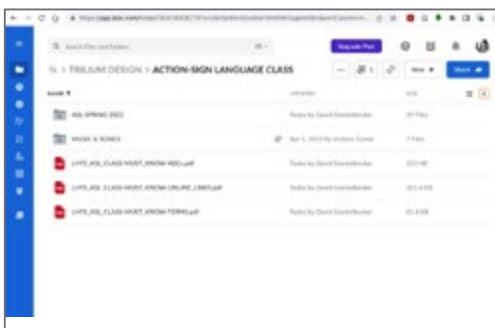
